



NSW Players Club Clearance Application Form (FROM JULY 1 2010)

It is a requirement of the Royal NSW Bowling Association that **any registered player who wishes to change their declared club** must obtain a clearance from their current declared club by completing this form. (A player's declared Club is the club at which they play their Association Events as defined in the Conditions of Play).

A Club Clearance is required for;

- Any Player who is **currently a registered member** of a club affiliated with the RNSWBA and wishes to change his declared club to another club OR
- Any Player who **has been a registered member** of a club affiliated with the RNSWBA in the **past 12 months** and wishes to change his declared club to another club.

A Club Clearance is **NOT** required for;

- A Player that has not been registered at a club affiliated with the RNSWBA in the past 12 months.

Please Note:

- A Club Clearance is required regardless of whether a Player has played in any Association Event during the past 12 months or whether a Player is a registered multi-member at both clubs that they wish to change between.
- This Player must be registered with the NSW Club he is transferring to prior to this form being submitted.
- A Club Clearance will not be considered as processed until payment and this completed form is received by the RNSWBA.
