Mixed Triples Conditions of Play

1. The World Bowls Laws of the Sport of Bowls in Australia shall apply except as modified hereunder.
2. The Controlling Body is the Men's bowling club Match Committee, which reserves the right to alter the advertised format in any way it considers necessary to bring the Carnival to a satisfactory conclusion. In particular if rain stops or delays play, the Match Committee reserves the right to determine on which end the game(s) shall be deemed to be completed.
3. There will be 5 sets of 3 bowl triples, each set comprising 6 ends. You will play a different team in every set. There will be 1 roll-up & that will be before the first set.
4. There will be no dead ends. If the jack goes out of bounds it must be re-spotted on the centre line either on or as near as possible to (a) the 2 metre mark or (b) the 6.5 metre mark, at the discretion of the non-offending team.
5. There will be 3 points awarded for a winning set (draw 1 ½ each) + 1 point for each end won (tie ½ each). Also 1 bonus point for an end won by 4 shots or more.
6. The overall prize winners will be determined by the most set wins with highest amount of points. Count backs will be determined by winning margins, then least shots against (A drawn set is considered a half win)
7. The winners of sets one, two, three, four & five will be the team with the most points scored in that particular set & if equal, count back above will apply as above.
8. All teams must be mixed.(Eg 2 men & 1 women or 2 women & man)
